

Hand Held Shower Head

Hand Held Shower Head Use

- Hand Held shower heads or detachable shower heads can be removed from a fixed position and held in the hand for more flexible and targeted water flow
- They are typically attached to a hose and mounted on a slide bar or a bracket, which allows for easy adjustment of the height and angle of the shower head

To Install

- Installation of this product should only be performed by a suitably qualified and licenced plumber following the instructions provided by the manufacturer of the device. If you have any concerns about the installation or use of this device please consult your nearest Country Care Group store.

PRECAUTIONS & SAFETY

- A non-slip mat can be used on the bottom of the bath to prevent feet slipping when reaching for tap to adjust water temperature
- Before getting out of the bath, be sure the hose is placed up out of the way and not tangled with your feet

MAINTENANCE & CLEANING

- Please check the product label / or user manual for specific cleaning instructions
- Do not unscrew the head as this will prevent a proper seal
- The plastic may perish faster if the water temperature is above 50°
- To prevent scaling, a plumber may be able to adjust the hot water thermostat to 50°
- Should the equipment appear damaged, **DO NOT USE.** It may require replacing
